Family Fun for Grades 1-2

Who is invited?

ALL family members of Grade 1 & 2 students.

How often do events happen?

Once a month, after school.

How do I find out when Family Fun is happening?

Where do gatherings happen?

In a room at the school, or at a place nearby.



Who are the LEADERS?

Parents and a team of volunteers. A school staff person and someone from a local agency are part of the team, too.

What happens at Family Fun?

- ✓ Parents play confidence-building games with their children.
- ✓ Parents/guardians have time to talk while children have supervised rec time.
- ✓ Special topics or speakers, based on families' interests.
- ✓ The group and parent leaders decide what they want to focus on, or do for fun.

Who supports Family Fun?

The school principal, teachers and a manager from Turning Points for Children. The School District of Philadelphia helps, too. Training and support is provided by the nonprofit FAST, Inc. Funding is provided by the U.S. Department of Education, Investing in Innovation program.

If students goes to Out-of-School Time (OST), can they go to Family Fun?
